SUMMARY	There was a total of four bus stop issues during February. • Three bus shelters were vandalized with one broken glass panel in each one: February 2 nd at 6 th & Western, February 4 th at 10 th & Taylor, and February 7 th at 10 th & Washburn. • On February 19 th , the bus stop/shelter at Grace Medical (19 th & California) was hit by a car and destroyed. Human Resources and Operations continue to interview applicants to fill open Operations positions, which include bus operators, a CSS, and a dispatch clerk. 22 bus operators received a safe driving award for having no chargeable accidents in 2022. The MOD microtransit team continued to work on providing MOD outreach to the public, improving processes and procedures, and monitoring metrics. MOD had its 100 th completed trip request on February 24th, 2023.
